Thank you for your interest in teaming with West Virginia/Maryland Women's Credo. Being a member of the team requires a full commitment from start to finish. The decision to team should not be considered lightly, as teaming is spiritually, emotionally and physically labor intensive. Please consider the following requirements as you seek the LORD in prayer about joining the team:

_____ 1. Team School: Team school is February 9, 2019, required for all new and returning team members who have never attended. Team School is a one-time event that is held on a Saturday morning and lasts approximately two hours.

_____ 2. Team members are to regularly attend a Christ centered Church and or small group. (Credo doesn't count as small group)

_____ 3. Teaming Meetings: There are eight team meetings, starting February 22, 2019. Team meetings are held on Friday evening, begin at 6:30 and last approximately three hours. Team members are required to attend each meeting in its entirety. Team meeting attendance is critical. Each team meeting builds on the one before it, just as each talk builds on its former during the weekend. When the team commits to building Christian community we become united under God's agenda; pray with one focus and serve with one goal. Therefore, team members are expected to attend all meetings in their entirety. The Rectora should be notified, in advance, if a meeting needs to be missed. If more than two team meetings will be missed, the team member should consider serving as an angel.

Team Meeting Dates: 2/22/19, 3/1/19, 3/8/19, 3/15/19, 3/22/19, 3/29/19, 4/5/19, and 4/12/19

_____ 4. Weekend Set-up: The team sets up the camp on the Wednesday evening before the retreat. The Rectora will announce the arrival time.

_____ 5. Retreat Weekend: Team members are required to be fully present, both physically and mentally for the entire retreat weekend. Women whose family and/or job obligations require them to divide their time and energy should change their status to "Angel". Leaving an activity or the retreat site for personal reasons, such as telecommuting, childcare issues or doctor's appointments is not permitted.

ALL team members remain with the group unless they are fulfilling a requirement of their job assignment. ALL team members are required to assist with clean up on Sunday after the closing.

_____ 6. Fees: The team fee for the spring of 2019 retreat is \$195.00. A \$25.00 deposit and a signed cover letter are required with the application. \$100.00 is due by the 4th week of teaming 3/15/19, remainder of fees are due by the 7th week of teaming 4/5/19. The candidate fee is \$165.00.

_____ 7. If you are part of an addictions recovery program, you must have at least 6 months clean.

_____ 8. Space Availability: We will accept applications and deposits until February 9, 2019. If team applications exceed the number of team openings we will have an anonymous drawing. You will receive your deposit back if space fills up. *In the event space is limited and you have decided to team in more than one location, please prayerfully consider being an Angel. This would be especially helpful to team members who are unable to serve elsewhere.*
